SUMMARY

This course prepares participants to earn a Risk Management Professional – Foundations certification. The training and examination are aligned with the ISO 31000:2018 Risk Management – Guidelines standard, which is applicable to organizations of all sizes, across all sectors, and for a wide range of risk contexts. Through an intensive and practical learning experience, participants build a solid understanding of the foundations of risk management as set out in ISO 31000:2018. The course combines instructor -led learning, applied exercises, and knowledge checks to support skill development and exam readiness. Participants will become familiar with the core concepts, terminology, principles, framework, and risk management process defined in ISO 31000:2018, and learn how these elements can be applied in real-world organizational settings. It introduces key companion standards, including ISO 31073:2022 (Risk Management—Vocabulary) and IEC/ISO 31010:2019 (Risk Assessment Techniques).

A certificate of “Certified ISO 31000 Risk management professional” will be issued to participants who successfully pass the exam and comply with all the other requirements related to this credential.




CERTIFICATION
